From time to time United Septic will receive several complaints regarding and odor from an aerobic septic system. Odor from Aerobic Systems are usually not detectable until pumps come on and the spray is introduced into the atmosphere. As a public service United Septic & Maintenance would like to give some helpful hints in regard to operating your Aerobic On-Sewage Facility.

You may be overloading your system

- Too much fat or grease being poured down the drain.
- Grinding too much food in the garbage disposal
- Sending too many paper products into the waste system
- Too much laundry on a single day or during short intervals
- Leaking faucets or toilets, draining into your system
- Multiple showers and baths within short intervals.
- Septic system cannot process as much water as a public, or city sewage system. All the water and products are remaining on your property, Water conservation is a must!

You may be killing your Aerobic Microbes

Aerobic Microbes must stay alive and active in your system. Micro Organism's are kept highly active by the air pump within the septic system these micro organisms can be killed off by what you allow to enter your system.

- Too many cleaning products.
- Anti Bacterial products
- Heavy Bleaches
- Fingernail polish Paint Thinners etc.

Owners of Aerobic Systems have unique responsibilities

Owners and Operators of On-Site Sewage Facilities are registered by the State of Texas as an Operator. State laws require that each Owner or Operator of an Aerobic System, have a service contract with a licensed Aerobic Installer. **This contract provides periodic inspections** of the water system.

Counties are required by law to Investigate Complaints Relating To Septic Systems

Any resident who does not take proper corrective action after receiving one of these orders will be summoned to J.P. Court.

Penalties are \$200.00

Penalties can be levied for each day of continuing violation. (Each day is a separate violation)

Aerobic Systems require periodic pumping of the tanks.

Over the years the tanks will accumulate enough solids to require the tanks to be pumped (2-4 years)
